PRESIDENT

Background

YPCC plays in the senior division of the Victorian Turf Cricket Association, and fields four teams who play at the Ryder and McAlister Ovals in Royal Park. YPCC have played at these grounds since 1945.

The Clubs unusual name is derived from Harry Youlden, our founding father and Kensington bookmaker who established Youlden Kensington Cricket Club in 1922. Youlden Kensington and Parkville Cricket Club merged in 1972 to create YPCC.

Purpose

To ensure YPCC is run efficiently and effectively to achieve its cricket, social and financial goals.

Responsibilities

- Chair regular meetings of the Club Committee;
- Prepare agenda items for the Club Committee in collaboration with Club Secretary, and circulate prior to meetings;

- Coordinate the preparation of an annual plan and budget;

- Able to publicly represent the Club at local and regional levels;
- Experience of working collaboratively with others;
- Experience of chairing meetings;
- Experience of leading others towards a shared goal

Accountability

- The President is accountable to the Club Committee and Club Members

Time Commitment and remuneration

Estimated time commitment is 2 hours per week. Club Committee meetings are 2 hours and occur once a month. The position is voluntary.
